The general objectives that are to be overcome with this seminar are: • Discover the educational possibilities of mobile devices to improve the teaching-learning process. • Investigate the didactic use of augmented reality and QR codes, exploring its pedagogical possibilities. • Design learning strategies to integrate mobile devices into teaching practice. • Explore tools and applications to integrate them into the design of activities and projects, linking them to Bloom's taxonomy. • Identify the verbs that accompany the different levels of the taxonomies to devise tasks through mobile devices • Know and spread innovative educational practices, to promote good practices in educational institutions and teaching teams.
